## Survey highlights and complete results - parent feedback

Our school exists to serve the local community - so feedback from the community is essential. This year, we asked both parents and children to provide feedback to the questions that Ofsted asks. A summary of the results is below, with a comparison to around 200,000 schools' responses, as collated by Ofsted (referred to as 'benchmark' below):

100% agree/strongly agree 'my child is well taught' (Ofsted benchmark - 88%)

97% agree/strongly agree 'my child is happy at school' (Ofsted benchmark - 92%)

96% agree/strongly agree 'my child makes progress' (Ofsted benchmark - 88%)

95% agree/strongly agree 'my child is looked after' (Ofsted benchmark - 90%)

93% would recommend Selwyn to other families (Ofsted benchmark - 86%)

Furthermore, across every question in the survey, the Selwyn results were more favourable than those in the Ofsted benchmark group. These results are meaningful, as over 40% of parents responded to the surveys.

95% 'enjoy school all/most/some of the time'

94% 'enjoy learning at school all/most/some of the time'

96% say that 'teachers help me to do my best in lessons all/some/most of the time'

96% 'feel safe at school all/most/some of the time'

I take part in school activities outside lessons, like clubs, sport, music and art (Response percentage = sometimes/frequently/very frequently)	79%
School encourages me to be independent and to take on responsibilities	86%
My school encourages me to respect people from different backgrounds and treat everyone equally (Response percentage = agree/strongly agree)	87%
My school provides me with useful information about my next steps, such as moving year groups or moving schools (Response percentage = yes, I received the right amount and it was helpful)	74%
I would recommend my school to a friend moving to the area	65%
