








We feel that a healthier and greener travel would help with our students become more active and help with the congestion caused at the main front gate.

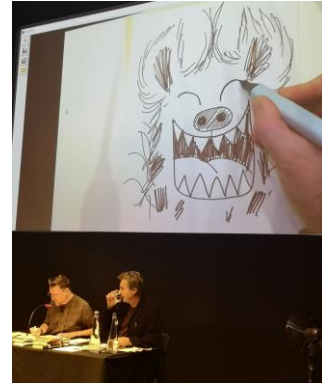
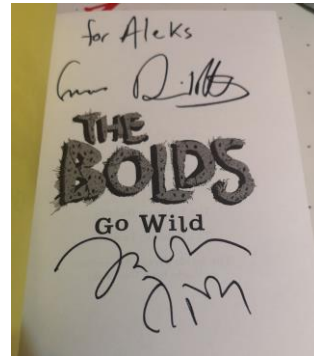
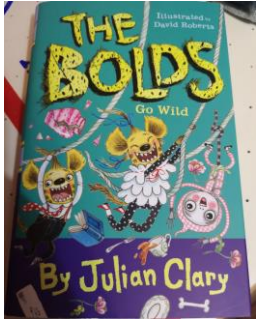
