We will continue practising our Phase 2 and 3 Phonics sounds and start exploring Phase 4.

We will use vocabulary and speech that is influenced by the children's experiences of books.

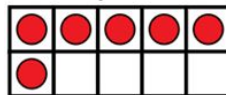


Spring 2 curriculum newsletter Reception

- Group items into fives and tens
