Listening and attention:

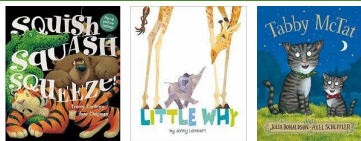
- join in with repeated refrains and anticipates key events and phrases in rhymes and stories.

Technology:

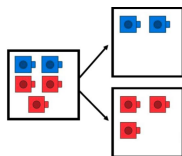
- know that information can be retrieved from computers
