Understanding the World

We will be exploring the world around us by:

- talking about our own experiences
- describing special times and events such as birthdays
- learning how to operate a computer device such as an ipad or controlling beebots



Maths

Through games and stories we will be:

- using number names and number language
- reciting numbers in order to ten
- counting how many objects there are
- playing with shapes and making arrangements with objects.
- finding familiar shapes in our environment



Physical Development

To develop physically we will:

- continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes and bikes) and ball skills.
- go up steps and stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet.
- skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold a pose for a game like musical statues.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be expressing ourselves by:

- dancing and moving like animals
- singing songs about jungle animals
- exploring how colours can be changed using paint, coloured water and light using construction materials to make homes for animals

Through a range of different activities, children will learn to:

- play in a group
- invite other children to play with them
- share toys and equipment
- express needs and preferences.
